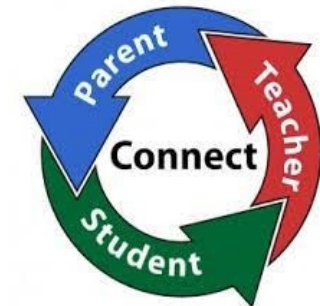

### Instruction used at CSJH:

Carrizo Springs Junior High provides their students a high-quality curriculum and instruction that enables children to meet the State's academic achievement standards.

Curriculum used:

Math uses Go Math Book and TEKS

Science uses McGraw Hill, Scientific Minds, Study Island, EdGenuity.

History uses EdGenuity, Study Island, and Prentice Hall Textbook

ELAR uses Houghton Mifflin Harcourt

All subjects use the TEKS Resource System TCMPC as a Scope and Sequence.

These curriculums are also used to achieve the Parent and Family Engagement School Goals for the 21-22 school year.

## Social and Emotional Support for the Learning Environment

The Carrizo Springs Junior High currently offers social emotional support for their students by:

- ◆ Creating a counselor's page on the CSJH website
- ◆ Offering referrals to students who may need counseling services
- ◆ Providing an introduction video explaining the role of the counselor
- ◆ Weekly (20 mins) Edgenuity sessions with students. The SEL content provides hundreds of dynamic and unique activities across a wide library of courses, all of which are thoughtfully taught by more than 80 engaging and diverse experts. ## School Goals

### Math

7th Grade- 7.3A Add, Subtract, Multiply & Divide Rational Numbers. **CSJH will increase from a 53% to a 60% for the 2021-2022 school year.**

8th Grade- 8.2D Order a set of real numbers arising from Mathematical and Real World Contexts. **CSJH will increase from a 47% to a 62% for the 2021-2022 school year.**

### Science:

8<sup>th</sup> Grade- 7.6(A) – Describe the structure of atoms, including the masses, electrical charges, and locations, of protons and neutrons in the nucleus and electrons in the electron cloud. **CSJH will strive for a 50% for the 2021-2022 school year.**

### History:

8<sup>th</sup> Grade- 8.1(B) – Explain the significance of the following dates: 1607, founding of Jamestown; 1620, arrival of the Pilgrims and signing of the Mayflower Compact; 1776, adoption of the Declaration of Independence; 1787, writing of the U.S. Constitution; 1803, Louisiana Purchase; and 1861-1865, Civil War. **CSJH will increase from a 40% to a 60% for the 2021-2022 school year.**

### ELAR:

7th Grade - 7.9(C) Analyze the author's use of print and graphic features to achieve specific purpose. **CSJH will increase from a 60% to a 70% for the 2021-2022 school year.**

8<sup>th</sup> Grade- 8.5(F) make inferences and use evidence to support understanding. **CSJH will increase from a 57% to a 62% for the 2020-2021 school year.**
