DATES SET FOR CARRIZO SPRINGS CISD STUDENT RETURN TO CAMPUS

As approved by the Texas Education Agency, Carrizo Springs CISD campuses would like to announce the following return dates for those students and parents who chose to return for in person instruction. However, parents who have selected remote learning for their students will continue to receive instruction from their respective campus.

Monday, October 19 – students in grades Pre- Kinder and kindergarten may return for in person instruction at Carrizo Springs Elementary.

Monday, October 26 – students in grades 1, 2, 3 may return for in person instruction at Carrizo Springs Elementary and those in grades 4 and 5 at Carrizo Springs Intermediate.

Monday, November 2 – students in grades 6 may return for in person instruction at Carrizo Springs Intermediate and those in grades 7 and 8 at Carrizo Springs Junior High.

Monday – November 9 – students in grade 9, 10, 11, and 12 may return for in person instruction at Carrizo Springs High School.

- **As per Texas Education Agency (TEA) guidelines, parents who choose either remote or in person instruction for their student must commit to a full (6 weeks) grading period.**

Prior to their students return to campus, parents will be provided a (Back to School Safety Plan for Staff and Students During COVID-19). The guide informs parents on procedures and guidelines that promote the health and safety of students and staff.
