## Carrizo Springs CISD Frank Carter Stadium Rules

- All students in 6<sup>th</sup> grade and below must be accompanied by a parent or adult to enter the stadium. Principals from CS Elementary and CS Intermediate will be on duty at the front gates to ensure this is done.
- Students in 6<sup>th</sup> grade and below must sit in the stands with a parent or an adult during the games.
- Students in grades 7<sup>th</sup> 12<sup>th</sup> may sit in the stands without an adult.
- Students attending the games must be seated on the bleachers. (No roaming under bleachers)
- Students are not allowed to bring backpacks into the stadium
- No one will be allowed to play or visit under the bleachers or within the stadium area.
- Students and parents are reminded that all football games are school-sponsored events and that the CSCISD Student Code of Conduct will be applied, if necessary.
- Spectators are not allowed to stand by the rail in the handicap area of the bleachers to view the game.
- Spectators must adhere to UIL and CSCISD expectations. Failure to do so could result in removal from the stadium.
- No bags/purses larger than 12"x12" will be allowed into the stadium. All bags are subject to search.
- Strollers will be allowed in the designated area on the home side.
- General admission ticket sales are online only. No in-person ticket sales. Link available at www.cscisd.net

## The following items ARE NOT PERMITTED in the Stadium:

- Illegal Drugs
- Alcohol
- Tobacco products / E-Cigarettes / Vape pens
- Weapons
- Balls of ANY type
- Flag Poles
- Ice Chests and Coolers

- Balloons
- Outside Food and Drinks
- Sunflower seeds
- Drink Containers (ex., Yeti cups or tumblers)
- Confetti / Glitter
- Large Signs
- Untrained Service Animals
- Paints ANY Type
- Aerosol Cans/Silly String

- Artificial Noisemakers (air horns)
- Baby powder
- Skateboards
- Student backpacks
- Frisbees
- Whistles
