

GF/CF Play dough recipe

2 cups white rice flour 4tsp cream of tartar 2/8 cup salt 2 tsp xanthan gum 4tbs oil

Place all ingredients into a food processor. Slowly add ½ cup boiling water until mixture forms ball. If dough is crumbly add more water one tablespoon at a time until dough is soft yet firm. Let cool. Knead on floured board for 10 minutes. Separate into 4 small balls of dough and add 8 drops of food coloring to each. It is best if you keep this play dough in the refrigerator.
